Actions or situations that may have occurred before the action in the main verb

Present subjunctive

of

"haber"

haya | hayamos

hayas

haya | hayan

Past Participle

ar = **ado**

er, ir = **ido**

Me alegro de que hayas trabajado de voluntario.  
I'm glad that you have worked as a volunteer
